Rain Painting

Turn a rainy day around.

Materials:
White paper Dry water color cakes (popped out of holders) OR washable markers

1 – Place the paper on a tray that can be set out in the rain

2 – Break up your watercolor cakes if using them. Putting them in a plastic bag and hitting with a hammer can be the most fun part of the project.

3 – Sprinkle the paper with the smashed pieces of watercolor paint in desired pattern. OR if using washable markers instead, color the paper as desired.

4 – Place the tray into the rain. It is best to place near a window or off of a porch so you can watch the process.

5 – The rain should make the colors run and bleed into one another giving the picture a tie dyed appearance.
